Both of the Range Coordinator positions will need the help of the general members to meet the time goals and objectives.

Our outdoor range had final approval in July 2013 and is now available for pistol caliber shooting as well as shotguns. This includes the creation of an action range which was one of the bigger projects completed for the club.

Two action shoots were held in 2013 with great success. Our first action shoot was in August with the second shoot in September. The monies raised from the September shoot allowed the club to contribute \$250 to Hospice Huntsville. Thanks to all members who came out to support and volunteer for this event!
